In 2018 his hybrid 'Deja Voodoo' (pictured) won the Society's Mary Swords DeBaillon Medal, the highest award given to a Louisiana iris cultivar. He's also past president and charter member of the Greater New Orleans Iris Society. Patrick is past officer and board member of the Society for Louisiana Irises.
