The name of the variety or seedling number should be <u>clearly marked on each rhizome</u>. In addition, the following information should accompany the plants on <u>a separate packing list</u>: hybridizer's name, full address, telephone number, name or seedling number, type of iris, height, color, bloom season and year of introduction (if introduced).

The date of the convention has been selected to coincide with peak or mid Siberian Iris bloom season here in central lowa so it would be advisable to send only those plants which should be in bloom at that time.
