4. \_\_\_\_ (T/F) The container should be short enough that the falls do not rest on the lip of the container but deep enough to display the flower and its perianth.
5. \_\_\_\_ (T/F) In the scale of points, overall beauty is comprised of 30 points.
6. \_\_\_\_ (T/F) Cultural perfection addresses how well the flower has been grown.
7. \_\_\_\_ (T/F) Trickery is allowed when grooming the Single Blossom Entries for exhibition.
8. \_\_\_\_ (T/F) Container Grown Iris are not eligible for Best Specimen of Show Award.
9. The Exhibition Judge must pass judgement in two areas: \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.
